Vildmosevej 2010-2015

Right through the Lille Vildmose a few main roads are made to connect the villages located on the edge of the bog. One of these roads is Vildmosevej. Vildmosevej connects Kongerslev in the west with the coastal road along the coast of Kattegat.

Many experience from their car the landscape in the minutes it takes to cross the bog. Along the road there are large areas flat as a pancake where the drivers often can watch the birds of prey foraging and large flocks of geese and other birds that restless change foraging ground out on the large bog area.

Before, the drivers from the roadside could watch the machines, particularly the small narrow gauged tracks with

tipping waggons that were carrying the sphagnum and the peat into the factory in Kongerslev. From the road you get an impression of the great limestone quarries, which still are in production outside the village Kongerslev.

My trips into the marsh have always started with a bike ride or a car trip on the road Vildmosevej out to the places in the bog, which I have chosen for the excursion of today. But I have also had many great experiences in the areas adjacent to the road.

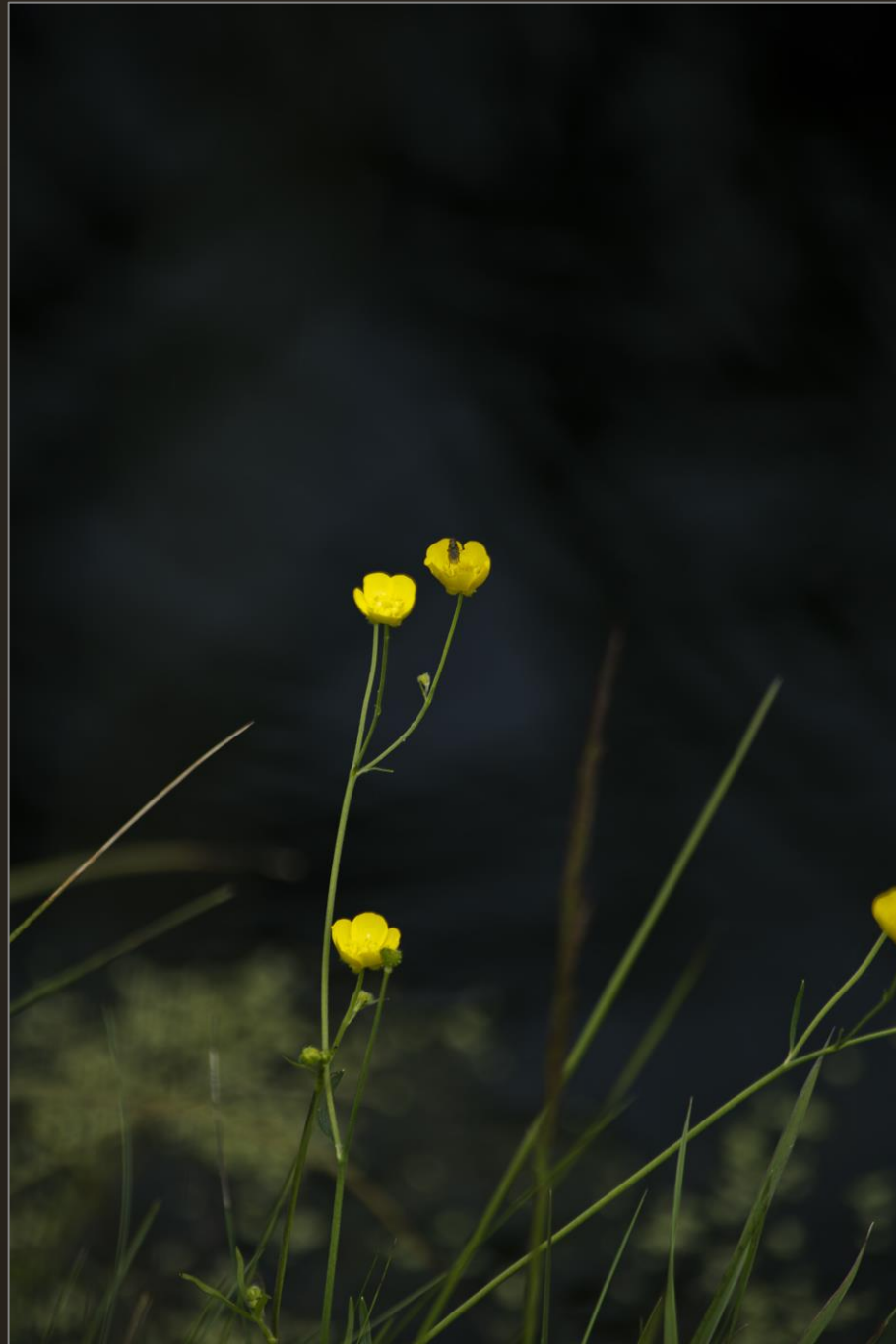
